Teacher Salary Increases

Below are projections if the base were to be increased by \$100M for teacher salaries each year. In short, putting in \$100M to the base, generates a state bill of approximately \$155M once it flows through the weights, and approximately \$65M for locals. This is commensurate with the increases the state has traditionally included to public education year over year, but less than the collective increase to locals.

If the base increases \$100M each year for teacher salaries, the State Board would be required to increase the minimum salary by \$1,250 each year as well. This ensures that these investments remain in place over time. At the rate listed above, the projected minimum salary over the next four years is:

2022: TDOE will recommend a minimum salary of \$40,000

2023: TDOE would recommend a minimum salary of \$41,250

2024: TDOE would recommend a minimum salary of \$42,500

2025: TDOE would recommend a minimum salary of \$43,750

2026: TDOE would recommend a minimum salary of \$45,000
