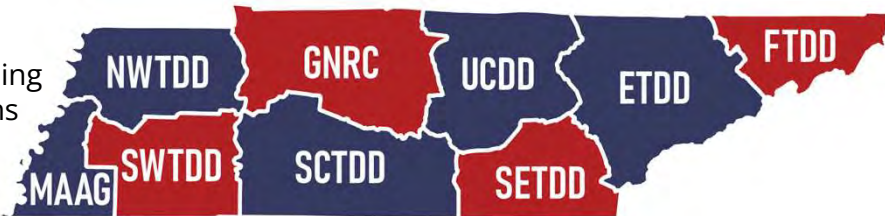




TENNESSEE DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT ASSOCIATION FY2022 IMPACT REPORT

Established by the Tennessee Development District Act of 1965, we exist to provide the most effective and efficient means for cities and counties to collaborate outside of their political boundaries.

We organize and carry out regional planning efforts, enable the delivery of social services to individuals who are aging or disabled, and facilitate regional economic development efforts.
